"Do You Have An Attitude?"

1. Our _____ is Who We Are!

"You brood of vipers! How can you speak good things, when you are evil?"
Matthew 12:34 "The mouth of the righteous is a fountain of life, but the mouth of the wicked conceals violence." Proverbs 10:11

One of the most difficult things in life is to reconcile *who we actually are, with who we want to be.*

2. Allow God to _____, _____, and _____ Our Attitude

"Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice! Let your gentleness be evident to all. The Lord is near. Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus." Philippians 4:4-7

I believe that we have to submit and surrender our hearts, our minds and our wills to God and allow Him to do what only He can do!

To have an attitude that exudes gratefulness and thankfulness has to come from the heart! And only God can change our hearts!
